

Safe systems of work as required by the Management of Health & Safety at Work Regulations 1999

Part of your legal obligations as an employer is to provide a safe place of work.

This is accomplished by firstly carrying out a risk assessment and thereafter providing a method statement.

The method statement will in certain circumstances require more in depth 'safe system of work' SSoW.

One of those methods is sometimes called a 'permit to work' and will include at time some complex procedures. They will also have to comply with current legislation such as:

- ✓ Electricity at work Regulations
- ✓ Confined spaces Regulations
- ✓ Work at height Regulations
- ✓ Hot works, Roof works, High Voltage electrical work, Asbestos, Excavation works, Demolition works Work on scaffold towers, mobile elevated working platforms (MEWPs)
